o provide the public with better access to health insurance services, the PhilHealth Region XII Office has moved its PhilHealth Express to its new location at *Barbekyuhan ng Bayan* Bldg., Magsaysay Street, M'lang, Cotabato on December 18, 2020.

Acting Regional Vice President, Dr. Hector Zenon Leonardo P. Malate said that the PhilHealth Express is ready to register new members, update records of existing members, issue Member Data Records/ PhilHealth IDs as well as assistance in the use of Electronic Premium Reporting System or EPRS among employers.
