PhilHealth conducts simultaneous nationwide Konsulta Summit

ore than six thousand Filipinos joined the first nationwide PhilHealth Konsulta Summit and Member Registration, the staterun health insurer's approach to bring its primary care benefits closer to the public last June 3, 2023.

The simultaneous nationwide Konsulta registration was held in different parts of the country; in the cities of Marikina, Dasmarinas, Naga, Iloilo, Talisay, General Santos, Ormoc, Cagayan de Oro, Cotabato, Marawi, Ysabela City in Basilan; and in the municipalities of Bataan, Buluan and Datu Odin Sinsuat in Maguindanao.

PhilHealth continuously intensifies its campaign to heighten the awareness of Filipinos on its primary benefits under the Konsulta Package. This package includes targeted health risk screening and assessment, initial and follow-up consultations, standard laboratory tests and 21 essential drugs and medicines as prescribed by the primary care physicians.

During the event in Marikina City, former Acting Department of Health Secretary and PhilHealth Board Chair Maria Rosario Vergeire in her video message said that studies had shown that primary care can address around 80 percent of people's common needs. She further emphasized the importance of primary care, saying that *"sa primary care maiiwasan ang paglubha ng mga sakit na kadalasan din ay mas mahal ang kinakailgang gamutan."*





On the other hand, PhilHealth Chief Emmanuel R. Ledesma Jr., stated the importance of the providers, adding that the health insurer targets to accredit 2,500 Konsulta Package providers this year. He further urged the health facilities to become accredited so that more members can register and avail of primary care services nationwide. *"Kumakatok po kami sa aming mga partner providers na suportahan ang kampanyang ito ng gobyerno upang sa gayon ay maramdaman ng ating mga kababayan ang isa sa mga layon ng Universal Health Care.", he said.*

After a brief presentation on PhilHealth benefits and services, the members were able to register and avail of consultation and health risk assessment with their chosen Konsulta Provider.
